	Room Parents	Year long	1-2 chairs & all parents support!	1 or 2 parents coordinate the class's parents to create a sense of community, support PAC events, coordinate playdates, and organize teacher birthday gifts.
	Parent Education Events	September, November, February and March	1-4 parents on organizing committee	Educational evenings for parents on topics of child development with our community and specialists. 3-4 topics throughout the year are usually organized on specific evenings from 5:30 – 6:30 with pizza; childcare provided.
	Fall Family Gathering & Spring Carnival	November and May	2 chair(s) and 10-20 volunteers	These two seasonal events foster community among the parents, children, faculty, and staff. Volunteers organize food, decorations, activities (photo booth, pumpkin painting, etc.) and set up for the Child's Day community at Zilker Park.
	December (2nd week)	Staff Holiday Breakfast	1-2 chair(s) and 2-3 volunteers	Parents celebrate teachers and staff for their dedicated work all year. Chairs order food, organize volunteers for setup and clean up, and greet staff and teachers.
	April	Week of the Young Child	2 chairs and 60-80 volunteers coordinating, setting up, and week-of support	An annual celebration presented by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. PAC funds special events and activities at Child's Day during this week to delight and honor our children! This is a great opportunity to visit and support your child inside the classroom.
	May (1 st week)	Staff Appreciation Week	1-2 chair(s) and 4-5 volunteers	Staff Appreciation Week gives parents the opportunity to honor and thank teachers and staff for their dedicated work all year. Suggestions: gift cards, breakfast, on-site massage; coffee drinks and gelato, sweatshirts, breakroom couch, thank you sign, thank you cards, and Yelp reviews celebrating individual teachers.
